ATA AWARDS AT SHOWS OTHER THAN THE NATIONAL TOPICAL STAMP SHOW

AWARDS

For shows with more than 500 pages in competition:

- BEST IN TOPICALS First Award (medal and ribbon)
- SECOND Award and THIRD Awards (medals and ribbons)

For shows with less than 500 pages in competition:

BEST IN TOPICALS Certificate

For all shows:

- ONE-FRAME AWARD (medal and ribbon)
- YOUTH AWARD (medal and ribbon)
- NOVICE AWARD (Book: "Adventures in Topical Collecting")

CRITERIA

- 1. The ATA defines a Thematic exhibit as one that develops a non-philatelic subject by illustrating it with a wide variety of appropriate philatelic elements, to tell a story, accompanied by thematic and philatelic text. Non-philatelic items may not be included. Thematic exhibits are eligible for all ATA awards.
- 2. The ATA defines a thematically-organized exhibit as one that develops a non-philatelic subject into a theme to tell a story, accompanied by thematic and philatelic text.
- 3. Thematically-organized exhibits in the "Display" division are eligible for all ATA awards.
- 4. Other thematically-organized exhibits such as Picture Postcard, Cinderella, First Day Cover, Advertising, Patriotic and Event Covers, Maximaphilly and Topical exhibits are eligible only for the Second, Third, Youth and Novice Awards.
- 5. Youth Award for the best multi-frame or one-frame Thematic or thematically organized exhibit.
- 6. Novice Award for the best multi-frame or one-frame first-time Thematic or thematically organized exhibit.
- 7. One-Frame Award for the best one-frame Thematic or thematically organized exhibit.
- 8. All award recipients must have received at least a Bronze in the show's competition
