Over its first 50 years, from 1945 through 1995, the UN was a vital force in helping to organize the nations of the world to try to bring Peace, Justice and Security to its peoples. This was directed by regular meetings and actions of its permanent organs, as well as many conferences on diverse subjects to bring the force of world opinion and action to address world problems.
